FEEDING RATE

Feed CALIBER® SENIOR AND SPECIAL-CARE HORSE RATION at a rate of 0.4 to 1 kg per 100 kg of horse body weight, depending on the horse's activity level, condition and dentition, as well as forage amount and quality offered. This works out to 1.8 to 4.5 kg per 450 kg horse or 4 to 10 lb. per 1,000 lb. horse. Feed alongside good-quality forage and water. For more detailed feeding instructions, please refer to label.
