



QUICK FACTS

A selective post-emergent herbicide for broad-spectrum grassy weed control in canola, flax and pulses.

ACTIVE INGREDIENT:	Clethodim
GROUP:	1
PACKAGING:	1 x 3 L Patron II + 1 x 9 L adjuvant
RAINFAST:	1 hour
WATER VOLUME:	5 – 10 gal/acre
STORAGE:	May be frozen
REGISTERED CROPS:	Alfalfa (seedling), canola, chickpeas, coriander, dry beans, faba beans, fenugreek, field peas, flax, lentils, mustard, potatoes, soybeans, sunflowers
APPLICATION RATE:	50 – 150 ml/acre (20 – 60 acres/case). Recommended rates are 20 – 40 acres/case.
TANK MIX OPTIONS:	MCPA Ester, Lontrel™, Pursuit®, Muster®, Liberty®, Interline™, Buctril® M, Curtail® M, glyphosate. *Apply tank-mix partner to registered crops only





TANK MIX ORDER

When tank mixing with glufosinate add surfactant first followed by glufosinate and then PATRON® II. For other tank mixes, mix herbicides first following W.A.L.E.S guidelines and add surfactant last.

PRO TIPS

- If there is a break in the spraying operation, agitate the mixture thoroughly before continuing.
- Do not allow the mixture to sit overnight.
- If tank mixing, always follow label directions for each tank-mix partner.
- Clethodim activity may be reduced by levels of bicarbonates over 500 ppm in the water.
- The addition of ammonium sulphate (AMS) at 1% v/v can help restore control.
- Shake well before using.
