FEEDING RATE

CALIBER® WORKING HORSE RATION is an excellent choice for horses with elevated nutrient requirements, such as active and growing horses. Feed CALIBER® Working Horse Ration at a rate of 0.1 to 0.5 kg per 100 kg of horse body weight depending on activity, growth and condition of horse as well as forage quality. This works out to 0.5 – 2.2 kg per 450 kg horse (or 1 – 5 lb. per 1,000 lb. horse). Feed alongside water and good-quality forage. For more detailed feeding instructions, please refer to the label.
