MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Fill clean spray tank 1/2 full with water; start agitation
2. Add the correct amount of Patron 240EC herbicide and continue to agitate
3. Add the correct amount of Patron adjuvant
4. Fill the spray tank with the remaining amount of water
5. Continue to agitate or run the bypass system
6. If there is a break in the spraying operation, agitate the mixture thoroughly before spraying
7. Do not allow the mixture to sit overnight
8. If tank mixing, always follow label directions for each tank-mix partner

Quick Tip: Clethodim activity may be reduced by levels of bicarbonates over 500 ppm in the water. The addition of ammonium sulphate (AMS) at 1% v/v can help restore control.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Always read and follow label directions.

*PATRON 240 EC applied at a rate of 60 acres per case should only be applied under the following conditions:

- Good crop stand
- When not tank-mixed with other pesticides
- Light to moderate weed infestation
- Absence of stress, good growing conditions
- Early application (as in above table, prior to tillering)
- Do not apply to volunteer winter cereals
- Adequate moisture and fertility

If any one of the above conditions is not present at the time of application, use the 40 acre per case rate of PATRON 240 EC.
