QUICK FACTS

A glyphosate additive for pre-seed control of herbicide-resistant weeds before canola.

ACTIVE INGREDIENT:	Carfentrazone and Bromoxynil
GROUP:	6, 14
PACKAGING:	1 x 2.4 L C-Zone and 2 x 9.7 L Brotex 4AT
RAINFAST:	2 hours
WATER VOLUME:	Ground application only: 10 gal/acre
STORAGE:	Do not freeze
REGISTERED CROP:	Canola (prior to seeding)
APPLICATION RATE:	15 ml/acre of C-Zone + 60 ml/acre of Brotex 4AT (160 acres/case)
TANK MIX REQUIRED:	Glyphosate (0.5 – 1 REL/acre)





TANK MIX ORDER

C-Zone (carfentrazone), Brotex 4AT (bromoxynil), Glyphosate.

KEY WEEDS CONTROLLED*

- Annual Sow Thistle
- Chickweed
- Cleavers
- Dandelion
- Flixweed
- Kochia (including group 2, 4 and 9 resistant biotypes)
- Lamb's Quarters
- Narrow-Leaved Hawk's Beard
- Russian Thistle
- Shepherd's Purse
- Smartweed
- Tall Waterhemp
- Wild Buckwheat
- Volunteer Canola (all biotypes)

*When tank mixed with glyphosate — refer to product label for detailed weed staging information.

PRO TIPS

- Canola can be seeded immediately after application
- For best results, spray in the heat of the day
- Octagon is a contact herbicide and must be applied directly on growing weeds for effective results
- Always use with glyphosate
