FEEDING RATE

Offer CALIBER® MARE AND FOAL RATION to nursing foals as a creep feed at a rate not to exceed 1 kg per 100 kg of body weight. Feed to weanlings and growing horses at a rate of 0.6 to 1.25 kg per 100 kg of body weight. Body condition, growth rate and potential of horse will influence foal- and growing-horse feeding rate.

Feed pregnant mares the ration at a rate of 0.5 to 1 kg per 100 kg of body weight, depending on stage of pregnancy and body condition.

Lactating mares should receive CALIBER® MARE AND FOAL RATION at a rate of 0.5 to 1.25 kg per 100 kg body weight, depending on level of milk production and foal's weight gain.

Forage quality will influence all feeding rates. Feed alongside high-quality forage and water. For more detailed feeding instructions, please refer to label.
